WORLD FOOD FEST



You have been placed on a geography team with some of your classmates, and your team will be choosing a continent to research. Although there are seven continents on the planet, we're only using five of them. No offense to Antarctica, but the population of the entire continent is far less than the population of Avon. Ba-bye. Australia? Well, it's a cool continent, and it is the home of the dingo, but it's like, really far away and stuff. Ba-bye Australia.

Once each team chooses a continent (which will be done through a lottery system), the team will research the countries on that continent. Each *team* will create a large map of the continent and a large poster promoting tourism to the continent. Each *student* will choose a specific country on the continent and write a short paper about the country (using Google Docs) OR create a Google Presentation about the country. Each student will also research traditional foods that would be eaten in that country and then be assigned a main dish, appetizer, or dessert. Students are responsible for making that dish and bringing it in to school for a *World Food Fest* Holiday Party on December 23.

Teams will:

- 1) Draw a large map of your continent, and include all the countries. The map should be neat, in color, and all the countries should be labeled. **One map per team.**
- 2) Draw a large poster advertising tourism on your continent. Your poster should be neat, in color, include pictures, the names of all the countries on your continent, and include at least five facts about your continent. **One poster per team.**
- 3) Teams will assign a different country on the continent to each student. The team will have to fairly decide how to handle situations where two team members want the same country.
- 4) Teams will assign each student a main dish, appetizer, or dessert for his/her chosen country. There may be more than one type of food assigned per team, but no more than two. (For example, there may be two desserts assigned, but not three.) Also, there must be at least one main dish, one appetizer, and one dessert per team.

Students will:

- 1) Each student will research recipes for his/her food choice, make the food, and bring it to school on December 23. The food should include a recipe card with the name of the food (main dish, appetizer, or dessert) and all the ingredients used.
- 2) Each student will either write a paper on his/her country (at least 300 words on Google Docs) or create a Google Presentation on the country (at least ten pages with pictures and writing on each page). Both options should include cool and interesting facts about the country.
- 3) Complete the team assignments with the group. Teams could decide how to divide up the tasks.
